- **Kitchen staff workers will be expected to stock stations with utensils, napkins, trays, condiments, etc., and will assist wait staff with any needs.**
- **Workers will clear tables and clean/prepare tables for next customers.**
- **Clean/sanitize various areas of restaurant. Clean/wash dishes.**

- **Employer does not intend to provide board, lodging, or transportation, but if requested by workers for their convenience, the Employer may provide the requested services and deduct a reasonable amount. The Employer will provide on-the-job training at no cost to the worker(s). Overtime may be offered. If offered and accepted, overtime hours will be paid at \$24.53 and 27.00 per hour if applicable. As applicable, the employer will reimburse in the first work week all visa, visa processing, border crossing and other related fees, as mandated by the government and not exceeding the mandated reimbursements.**
- **If the worker completes 50% of the work contract period, employer will either arrange reasonable outbound transportation and subsistence, reimburse the worker for transportation and subsistence, or issue advance payment for the transportation and subsistence. Upon completion of the work contract or where the worker is dismissed earlier, employer will provide or pay for worker's reasonable costs of return transportation and subsistence back home or to the place the worker originally departed to work, except where the worker will not return due to subsequent employment with another employer or in the event that the worker abandons the worksite or resigns without just cause.**
- **The amount of transportation payment or reimbursement will be equal to the most economical and reasonable common carrier for the distances involved. Daily subsistence will be provided at a rate of \$16.78 per day during travel to a maximum of \$68.00 per day with receipts.**
